PRESENTATION :

PermaPro Deco Micro Top Cement is a fine mortar formulated containing white cement, of selected aggregates and additives. PermaPro Deco Micro Top Cement was especially formulated to guarantee a great tensile strength and for fine applications as well in interior as in outside. Its texture is silky, brilliant and resistant. PermaPro Deco Micro Top Cement can be applied to any surface.

HOW TO USE :

The support will have to be resistant, finest possible, clean, dry and devoid of any moisture. To use the PermaPro range for any cleaning projects (grease, oil, stains).

On porous surface as concrete, plaster or mortar, apply PermaPro Prim.

1. Mix 2 kg of powder with +/- 470 to 500 ml of resin until obtaining a homogeneous mixture.
2. Apply the 1st layer with a small trowel. The layers will have to be 1 to 2 mm maximum thickness. This layer serves as a base for the top coat. Its surface can be smoothed with a sponge in order to remove all edges or defects.
3. Apply one 2nd layer when 1st is dry.

Once dry, it is possible to sandpaper surface according to the required effects and texture.

The temperature of application lies between 5° and 25°. In hot weather, to humidify the support beforehand.
